Welcome! Thank you for your interest in the San Lorenzo Dog Training Club.

This information sheet is provided to answer any questions you may have regarding your training class at SLDTC. If you have any problems or unanswered questions, please do not hesitate to call anytime Monday through Thursday between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the above telephone number.

You are welcome to come and visit the classes but please do not bring your dog.

**NOTE:** You must complete the sign-up card, read and sign the Training Rules & Regulations, pay the required fee, and show proof of canine vaccinations **PRIOR** to the first night of class.

On you first night of class, please check in with the Training Coordinator or person working the desk so that we know you are present. (**Remember: There are NO REFUNDS of fees.**)

For the beginning obedience class you will need proper training equipment: a collar and 6-foot leash. The collar may be a slip collar (sometimes called a "choke chain"), a pinch (or "prong") collar, or in some cases a buckle collar. Your trainer will help you choose the correct collar for your dog on the first night of class. We recommend using a leather leash, as it is easier on your hands than nylon. **WE DO NOT ALLOW CHAIN, ROPE, OR FLEXI (RETRACTABLE) LEASHES IN CLASS** – they are impossible to work with. SLDTC has training collars and leashes available for sale at reasonable prices.

**PLEASE NOTE:** NEVER leave a training collar (slip or pinch) on an unsupervised dog, and never use it as an everyday collar. You dog's tags and ID's should be on a plain buckle collar.

Our classes emphasize positive reinforcement, so bring a supply of your dog's favorite treats. They should be small, tasty, and easily swallowed (please, no giant biscuits!) If your dog has a favorite small toy, that can also be used as a reward.

Please do not feed your dog within at least two to three hours of coming to class. Also, remember to allow your dog an opportunity to relieve itself prior to class. If an accident occurs, equipment is available to clean up. Owners are required to clean up after their dogs, including outside of the building and anywhere in the building parking lot.

Anytime you are at the Club, please do not park in front of **534-E**. This business needs the parking spaces in the evening. If all allowed spaces are occupied, you may park in available spaces at the auto supply building in front. Please, **DO NOT** park along the cyclone fence, as this is a fire lane.

We look forward to having you in our class and we hope you and your dog enjoy this experience. See you soon.

## SAN LORENZO DOG TRAINING CLUB, INC. TRAINING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The San Lorenzo Dog Training Club, Inc. (hereinafter "SLDTC") is not responsible for lost or stolen items or any act of vandalism.
- 2. No dog is to be left unattended inside the building. Dogs are to be left in vehicle until handler has checked in and class is ready to start.
- 3. The trainer will use training methods consistent with SLDTC guidelines.
- 4. As a last resort, the trainer has the right to pepper spray any dog attacking another dog or person.
- 5. Payments are not refundable except for special circumstances that must be reviewed by the SLDTC Board of Directors.
- 6. Handler/owner takes full responsibility for her/his dog's actions with regard to harm caused to other dogs or persons on the SLDTC premises.
- 7. Handlers must keep their dogs at their sides and not allow them out at the end of the leash while in the building, except when instructed to do differently by the trainer.
- 8. The trainer has the right to require aggressive dogs to wear both a prong collar and a choke chain while on SLDTC premises.
- 9. The trainer has the authority to dismiss and/or drop any <u>overly aggressive</u> or out of control dog from class. If dropped from the class, the trainer must notify the SLDTC Board of Directors immediately. The unused portion of the training fees will be returned to the owner/handler by mail.
- 10. The trainer has authority to determine which dogs are stable enough to be off-leash for applicable exercises.
- 11. The owner or handler must inform the trainer if their dog has bitten a dog or person or has been ordered by the court to attend an obedience class.
- 12. No wolf or wolf hybrid will be allowed in any class or on the SLDTC premises.
- 13. Parent's or guardian's signature is required if handler is under eighteen years of age.
- 14. Children must remain seated and quiet behind the fences during training classes.I have read, understand and agree to abide by the above rules and regulations.
